

Guide for Activating Wi-Fi Calling

For improved mobile phone reception, instead of using the cellular network it is possible to use the **Wi-Fi Calling** feature provided by your phone carrier.

iPhone

Confirm that the Wi-Fi setting shows you are connected to Wi-Fi.

Select the **Settings** icon

Select **Cellular**

Select **Wi-Fi Calling**

Move Slider to **On** for **Wi-Fi Calling on This iPhone**

You'll see a warning about location data and what your carrier collects. Select **Enable** to turn on Wi-Fi Calling.

For some carriers, like AT&T, you may be redirected to a Safari webpage, where you're asked to agree to terms and conditions. Select **Continue**

Provide an Emergency Call address (in case you dial 911 and they can't locate you on Wi-Fi, this gives emergency responders a place to send assistance). Type your "**Address, City, State, and Zip Code**" and select **Verify address**

Android phone (Many Android varieties exist and these instructions are representative only)

Confirm that the Wi-Fi setting shows you are connected to Wi-Fi.

Select **Apps** icon

Select **Settings** then search for "**Wi-Fi Calling**"

Select **Turn Wi-Fi Calling On**

Select **Prefer Wi-Fi** for making calls
