Proposed Action or Project Description:

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

This project will renovate the 12 Camp Cafeteria, Building 12-30, to an acceptable condition for utilization during training exercises conducted by the DOE Office of Secure Transportation (OST). The work includes:

1. Renovation of the cafeteria electrical system, including cables circuit breakers, and transformers
2. Renovation of the cafeteria fire suppression system, including extension of the existing sprinkler system and replacing the fire alarm panel
3. Replace of the kitchen equipment
4. Renovation of the cafeteria HVAC system by repairing or replacing obsolete heat pumps, kitchen vents, and makeup air handlers
5. Installation of a new security alarm cable near the cafeteria to alarm customer trailers and magazines
