## **Proposed Action Description:**

HVAC units at Building A-1 3 at the North Las Vegas Facility are old and need to be replaced. For this project, 6 HVAC units would be replaced on the A-13 roof. The old units would be replaced with new Energy Star rated units. Old roof insulation/weatherproofing membrane would be removed , and new insulation/weatherproofing membrane would be installed. HVAC work would be done by NSTec, while the roofing work would be performed a subcontractor.

The project is anticipated to take approximately 24 working days.
