U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 5 p.m., Wednesday, March 25, 2015, at the Frank H. Rogers Science and Technology Building, 755 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada. The planned meeting topic includes a briefing and development of a recommendation on FY 2017 baseline prioritization of Environmental Management activities at the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS).

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session will begin at 4 p.m. on Radioactivity and Radioactive Decay by Walter F. Wegst, Ph.D.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS.
