U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 5 p.m., Tuesday, November 10, 2015, at the Frank H. Rogers Science and Technology Building, 755 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada. Planned meeting topics include briefings and recommendation development related to the groundwater long-term monitoring plan and the cleanup of historic above-ground nuclear testing locations at the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS).

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session will begin at 4 p.m. on Water Levels 101 by Nicole DeNovia, Golder Associates, Inc. and Joseph Fenelon, U.S. Geological Survey.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS, formerly known as the Nevada Test Site.
