U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 20, 2016, at the Beatty Community Center, 100 A Avenue South, Beatty, Nevada. Planned meeting topics include a briefing on groundwater near Rainier Mesa and Shoshone Mountain and an update on storm impacts from October 2015 on the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS).

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session will begin at 4 p.m. on the Central Nevada Test Area by Mark Kautsky, DOE Office of Legacy Management.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS, formerly known as the Nevada Test Site.
