U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, November 7, 2018, at the Frank H. Rogers Science & Technology Building, 755 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada. The meeting will focus on providing an overview on the Emergency Preparedness Working Group grant and a groundwater communication plan for DOE Environmental Management (EM) Nevada Program activities on the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS).

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada and bordering Shoshone, California residents who provide recommendations to the DOE EM Nevada Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS. Topics regarding Yucca Mountain and national security are not within the purview of the NSSAB and will not be addressed during the meeting.
