

# CODE OF CONDUCT

## NEVADA SCIENCE BOWL CONDUCT RULES:

- All team members are expected to conduct themselves with courtesy and respect at all times. All team members will treat others with courtesy and respect at all times. Team Members must respect personal, private and public property. Any team responsible for damages will receive a bill.
- The use of threatening or foul language is not tolerated.
- No fighting or arguing with volunteers, team members or other teams.
- Appropriate shirts and shoes are required at all times. Team members wearing inappropriate attire (not in good taste) could be grounds for individual and team disqualification.
- Smoking or using tobacco products in buildings is prohibited.
- Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited.
- Overnight accommodations provided by Nevada Science Bowl are assigned by gender. Young men and young women are not allowed in each other's rooms. Once rooming assignments are made, there will be no changes unless specifically authorized by the Nevada Science Bowl coordinator.
- The Nevada Science Bowl enlists the assistance of an Ombudsman. This individual will resolve any disputes that may arise.
- The Nevada Science Bowl is a team event. Therefore, one team member's behavior can jeopardize the eligibility of the entire team. Complaints received from volunteers, other teams, the National Atomic Testing Museum, the hotel or VegasPBS regarding behavior are grounds for disqualification from the competition.
